

ETA SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

To be eligible for an ETA Scholarship, an applicant must meet the following criteria:

- Dependent of current ETA member
- Graduating from high school during current school year
- GPA of 2.0 or higher (based on 4.0 scale) after 7 high school semesters
- Plan to attend a formal accredited training program (trade school, cosmetology, etc.) or a two/four-year accredited college/university this fall

Selection Process: Three \$750 ETA Scholarships will be awarded. Winners will be chosen by random draw of all eligible applications received.
